FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION

The Workshops at Howe Hill Farm is committed to offering financial assistance to make the arts more available to more people. Financial assistance decisions are based on need and we offer financial assistance through partial or full scholarships. Consideration for assistance is first given to those who have not previously received aid from HHF, and to those who can show greatest financial need. Applications are reviewed by an internal team at HHF and the course instructor. Applying for a scholarship does not guarantee award. Students will be notified 7 days prior to the start of the course if they have been granted a full or partial scholarship. Unused scholarships cannot be transferred to another course.

To apply:

- 1) Complete separate application for each person applying for aid.
- 2) Submit the completed Financial Aid application form by the deadline date (30 days prior to the start of the workshop you are applying for). There is NO FEE to apply for financial assistance. Completed applications can be emailed to info@hesslercreative.com.
- 3) Incomplete applications will not be considered for scholarships so be sure to include with your completed application your 3-5 portfolio samples and your 3-7 paragraph personal statement.
- 4) All notifications will be made 7 days prior to the start of the workshop. If financial aid is granted, applicants are required to notify HHF if they wish to accept or decline the award. If a partial scholarship is granted, students must pay the balance due prior to the start of the workshop. If needed, arrangements can be made for a weekly payment plan over the course of the workshop. Unused financial aid cannot be deferred to another workshop.

For all image submissions, please submit jpegs at 2,000 pixels on the longest side.

For written works, please submit a .pdf or .docx file.
